

Eemu Myntti: The unfinished portrait of architect Alvar Aalto

This unfinished painting is interesting, because it tells about Eemu Myntti's painting process. The painting was presumably going to be a portrait of the architect Alvar Aalto.

Why the process was interrupted is not known, nor whether Myntti had an intention to continue the painting. It is interesting that the background is coloured with bright colors, which only briefly appear in Myntti's finished paintings. He usually painted softer colors on top of strong color layers. Compare for example Self portrait, left side.
